eLibraryUSA is available exclusively at American Spaces for its members. It offers over 35 resources to help American Spaces members learn about academic research, learn English, and find out more about American culture and politics. Here is a sample of the resources eLibraryUSA has available:

## ACADEMIC RESEARCH

### Academic OneFile

**Academic OneFile** has articles almost 8,000 academic journal and general interest magazines. You can use it to research such subjects as physical and social sciences, technology, medicine, engineering, the arts, technology, literature, and more.

### JSTOR

**JSTOR** has more than 850 academic journals for students researching arts, humanities, social sciences, economics, history, political science, and regional studies.

### ProQuest Dissertations and Theses Global

**ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global** has over 1.5 million graduate dissertations and theses from over 700 schools. The dissertations cover a wide range of topics, from mathematics to business administration to sociology. You can search by topics and you can also search for work at specific schools.

### ProQuest Research Library

**ProQuest Research Library** ProQuest Research Library includes over 6,400 academic journals, trade journals, and general interest magazines. You can use it to research such subjects as business, the arts, women's studies, health and medicine, education, literature and languages, and more.
